Dear Parents,

**Phase 3** begins Monday, November 15th! Full days all week! This opportunity is all thanks to the success we have been blessed with in Phases 1 and 2. We thank you for your attention to BAIS health and safety protocols and for keeping children at home when there is uncertainty of their health status. If we all do our part, we will all be safer and more successful.

Here are some important pieces of information and reminders:

- Classes will be held on campus, Monday-Friday, for all grades, from 7:45am-3:00pm.
  - Exceptions:
    - PreK students who only stay for a half day (leave at 11:55)
    - Secondary students who do not have 0 (zero) period (start at 8:30)
    - All Wednesdays are "late-start"; classes begin at 8:30 (no zero period)
- Gates open for drop-off at 7:30 on all days except Wednesday (8:20).
- All students attending classes on campus must have a signed waiver turned in to the office.
- School lunch service will begin on Nov.15th; Contact [srimumlyati@baisedu.org](mailto:srimumlyati@baisedu.org) with questions, or stop by the office
- Holding to your choice of offline or online classes is critical for student success and teacher planning. Students and teachers do best when a routine is established. If you choose to keep your child at home, please be mindful of the impact it has on their learning and on their teachers' ability to properly plan lessons and assessments.
- Online options remain available for families who:
  - Are uncomfortable with in-person schooling for personal, health related reasons.
  - Have children (or others in the household) who are covid-19 symptomatic or are showing signs of illness.
  - Are out of the country due to travel complications or lack of vaccination availability.
  - Need to travel for family emergencies or governmental requirements.


